

Sonae Indústria wins the Euronext Lisbon Awards 2018 in the category “Listed Company - Best Performance”

Sonae Indústria wins, for the first time, the Euronext Lisbon Awards in the category “Listed Company - Best Performance”. This award excels the performance of listed companies on Euronext Lisbon in 2017.

The ceremony took place on 20 February 2018 as part of a broader event, “*Conferência Via Bolsa*”. This year’s theme was *Growth is Back* and the event brought together a diversified audience comprising entities such as investment banks, listed companies, analysts, fund managers and law firms. The event aims to reward best performance in 2017 by acknowledging the companies, institutions and persons who outperformed in the Portuguese capital market.

A Euronext Lisbon’s press release refers to Paulo Rodrigues da Silva words, CEO Euronext Lisbon, who highlighted that “This is the moment to reward the best that was done in 2017 in the capital market, but it is also the moment to address the future. The capital market changed and is different from the past: more global, more focused, present more institutions than individuals and more regulated. There is an increased number of new financial vehicles, new kind of entities, more technology. This is a challenge for smaller entities and countries but also an opportunity for innovators and entrepreneurs.” (...) “This is a new reality. A new reality we must understand and which constitutes a challenge to each of us.”
